

Minutes for Baker County Band Boosters Meeting

Call to Order

A meeting of the Baker County Band Boosters was held on January 11, 2022, in the BCHS band room. It began at 6:46 p.m. and was presided over by Elena Lowther.

Treasurer's Report: No treasurer's report at this time though it was reported by Elena that we made around \$2,400 profit at Breakfast with Santa.

General Business

1. The goal of the meeting was to discuss the planning of the solo and ensemble event on February 18 and 19 and other spring considerations
2. Mr. Moore discussed the following actions needed in regard to solo and ensemble:
 - a. work with Mike Scott on signage
 - b. review the parking situation
 - c. confirm with Jennifer the catering needed for the directors' meal
 - d. find an alternate parent who can work with Andrew on concessions. Due to health concerns, Andrew may not be able to run the concession stand effort.
 - e. volunteer parents needed for the event. The January 31st BCBB meeting will replace the February booster meeting and will be dedicated to direct planning of solo and ensemble.
 - f. student training meeting is set for February 11th from approximately 3:00-5:00 p.m.
3. We discussed the end-of-the-year trip which is still up in the air due to the school district's policy of no end-of-year trips. Mr. Moore has discussed the possibility with Mr. Canon who suggests we look into the option of performing at Universal. The trip would need to be an overnight one. We are still gathering information from Stacey and Mike.
4. We tabled the idea of Music in the Park as the solo and ensemble event is all-consuming at this point.
5. The music camp scholarships and the senior college scholarships were discussed. The summer camp scholarship is \$150 for a high school student and \$100 for a middle school student. The directors will get the application information out to their students. The deadline for submission is April 1st. The college scholarship is for \$750 and is available to students seeking an academic degree or a certification degree. The deadline for submission of the application is also April 1st.
6. Mr. Moore and Elena announced that the following board positions will be coming open this spring: president, vice president [possibly], treasurer, secretary, and color guard liaison. We encourage band parents who can donate their time to this needed endeavor to please consider taking on a position.

7. Mr. Keel made the request to the boosters to help pay for recent expenses of lyres, books, mouthpieces, and reeds @ \$700. The board will need to vote to approve. There was not a quorum present at the meeting.

Announcement: The mandatory informational band parent meeting is set for March 18, 2022.

Action Items

1. Plan signage for solo and ensemble event.
2. Plan parking arrangements for the S & E event.
3. Plan concessions for S & E.
4. Plan catering meal for directors at S & E.
5. Stay in touch with Mr. Canon regarding end-of-year trip to secure approval by school board. This may involve parents getting involved.
6. Gather all the information on Universal [end-of-year trip] from Mike and Stacey.
7. Get information out to students regarding summer music camp scholarships and college scholarships
8. Approve Mr. Keel's request for money to cover supply expenses
